Universitas Studiorum Since 1361

The University of Pavia is **one of the world's oldest Academic Institutions**.

It was founded in 825 as a "School of law, rhetoric and liberal arts" by King Lothair I, and in 1361 it was officially established as a "Universitas Studiorum" by the Holy Roman Emperor Charles IV.

Thanks to the reforms implemented during the 18th century by the Empress Maria Theresa of Austria and her son Joseph II, the University of Pavia became **one of the foremost in Europe**, boasting an impressive number of **famous Alumni, celebrated Academicians and Nobel Prizes**.

Nowadays the University of Pavia is an **Internationalisation-driven University** which participates in agreements with worldwide esteemed institutions, an advanced **Research University** which promotes innovative interdisciplinary projects, and a **Job-oriented University** which creates powerful networks and strong business chances.

The **excellent Student-Faculty ratio** guarantees all students a personalised learning path and enhances the quality of teaching and the overall University adventure. Moreover Pavia, with 70.000 permanent residents and over 26.000 students, is a **student-sized environment** and has been a **City-Campus** since its foundation, offering the unique experience in Italy – and rare in Europe – of living in one of the **21 University Residences** of the City.

With a wide variety of both Academic and social opportunities, Pavia is the **ideal place** to choose for studying and living abroad.

Located in **Lombardy Region**, only 30 kilometres south of Milan, the City of Pavia offers a lively, genuine, cooperative and safe environment with a high quality of life. Pavia is the Capital of the fertile **Province of Pavia**, which is known for a variety of agricultural products -including wine, rice, cereals and dairy products- and is situated at the heart of **Italy's manufacturing district**.

Founded in Roman times, from 568 to 774 Pavia became the Capital of the Lombard Kingdom, and its fascination remains intact with the centre's maze of narrow streets, ancient churches and elegant buildings, all bordered by the **Ticino river**.

The countless events, festivals, exhibitions, concerts, meeting places and sports competitions combine to offer students a unique University experience.

In addition to enjoying the advantages and services of **nearby Milan**, Pavia is close and well connected to the Swiss border and many of the **major tourist attractions** of Northern Italy: the Ligurian coast, the lakes of Como and Garda, the mountain range of the Alps.

The University at a glance

An International University

Internationalisation is **one of the core concepts** of the University of Pavia, which during the last few decades has been enhancing its presence in the Worldwide Higher Education arena. The drive towards internationalisation pervades all aspects of Academic life.

The University's international participation is continuously increasing through numerous **Mobility opportunities** both for students and teaching staff, a wide range of **English-taught Degree programs, Bilingual Degree programs, Double Degree programs, Joint Master's Degrees** and various **Language courses** in the Academic offer, as well as prolific **Research collaborations** with foreign Universities and Centres.

INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY

The University of Pavia was **one of the first Institutions in Europe** to accept Erasmus students and has always encouraged the exchange of students and teaching staff all over the world, counting on a network that now consists of more than **500 International partnerships and Exchange agreements**.

The University has established enduring relations with prestigious Universities located in **all EU and many Non-EU countries** around the world, including: Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, India, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Iceland, Japan, Jordan, Lebanon, Mexico, Morocco, Nepal, Palestine, Russia, Singapore, Switzerland, Taiwan, Thailand, Tunisia, United Kingdom, USA, Vietnam.

The University of Pavia offers its students a series of **Exchange programs**:

Erasmus Plus, combining study and traineeship in EU and Non-EU countries, and including mobility opportunities within the European Alliance "European Campus of City Universities - EC2U";

Coimbra group Students Exchange Network, a study period at one of the most ancient Universities in the world;

Overseas Exchange Program, a study period at one of the most technologically advanced Universities in Non-EU countries, such as Argentina, Australia, Canada, Japan, Taiwan, USA;

Fund for Cooperation & Knowledge, combining study and traineeship in Developing Countries;

International Summer and Winter schools and **Erasmus Blended Intensive programs**.

All programs are covered by **scholarships** for study-abroad experiences.

EUROPEAN CAMPUS OF CITY UNIVERSITIES

Since 2017 the University of Pavia has been a member of the Alliance "**European Campus of City Universities - EC2U**", that brings together **7 historical and multidisciplinary Universities** (Coimbra, Iasi, Jena, Pavia, Poitiers-coordinator, Salamanca, Turku) which share a strong international vocation and at the same time a deep rootedness in the territory, a factor that makes them City-Universities. The associated partners include the seven municipalities, as well as other socio-economic players in the area (Technology centres, Student associations, Chambers of commerce).

The aim of the Alliance is to create a true **Pan-European Campus**, building a shared Governance pattern, exponentially increasing Mobility within the 7 Academic communities and developing innovative models in the fields of Education, Research and Third mission.

The actions of the project, such as the establishment of **Joint Master's Degrees** and **Virtual Institutes**, will be developed around the following **United Nations Sustainable Development Goals**:

- Good health and well-being
- Quality education
- Sustainable cities and communities

CENTRE FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AND DEVELOPMENT

CICOPS was established in 1984 in order to foster win-win relations between the University of Pavia and Universities in Developing Countries.

The Centre is committed to **human and institutional development** in these countries: among other activities, it manages Cooperation projects and Joint Research initiatives, offers professional training and collaboration to local Institutions such as Hospitals, awards scholarships to researchers and encourages student exchanges.

Research is a **primary mission** for the University of Pavia, which implements and actively fosters Interdisciplinary research, Collaborations with prestigious Universities all over the world, Knowledge transfer and Industrial projects with both local and global realities. All this makes the University of Pavia **one of the most advanced Universities in Italy** for Basic research, Applied research and Knowledge transfer.

BASIC RESEARCH

The University of Pavia enjoys **International prestige** in many Research areas, as demonstrated by the numerous awards assigned to Teaching and Research staff, the consistent competitive funding obtained for leading Research projects, and the collaborations with the most qualified Universities and Research Centres around the world.

The University attributes strategic importance to the constant improvement of Research facilities and infrastructures, counting on **18 Departments, 19 Interdepartmental Research centers** and many **large Infrastructures** with cutting-edge scientific and technological features.

Moreover, the University is aimed at increasing its Human capital of excellence, by investing in young Researchers and stimulating their skills, creativity and passion for knowledge.

Research is carried out through funding from the University itself, the Lombardy Region, Italian Ministries, the European Union, local and national Foundations, private companies and citizens (thanks to the University's Crowdfunding platform "Universitiamo", launched in 2014).

For the period 2018-2022, the Italian Ministry of University and Research has identified **5 Departments** of the University of Pavia (Biology, Physics, Mathematics, Molecular medicine and Humanities) among the "**Departments of Excellence**" at national level, and has awarded them a 37 million euros funding which will be used to support the recruitment of Teaching and Research staff, the organization of highly qualified teaching activities and the purchase of state-of-the-art infrastructure and equipment.

Based on these remarkable results, in a normalized ranking based on the number of Researchers per University, the University of Pavia ranks **2nd in Lombardy** and **8th in Italy**.

APPLIED RESEARCH AND KNOWLEDGE TRANSFER

The University of Pavia is committed to enhancing the results obtained by its Researchers, in cooperation with other Research centers or companies, with the aim of **creating value** and **responding to current International challenges** - cultural, social, economic and technological.

The valorization of Research results and the transfer of Knowledge originated in the University can take place in different ways, including publication in trade journals, presentations at conferences for experts or events for the general public, Patenting and creation of Spin Offs.

The University actively participates in the most prestigious **National and International Networks** established along with other Universities, Research centers and companies, and cultivates its relationship with local authorities and associations.

In addition **the University of Pavia**, primarily with its 5 Medicine Departments, **is the core of an INNOVATION ECOSYSTEM** consisting of Institutions, Research centers and private companies with which the University actively collaborates in Research activities. The Ecosystem includes:

IRCCS

Pavia's Hospitals of Excellence (Policlinico San Matteo, Istituto Maugeri, Istituto Mondino) pursue research purposes in the Biomedical field and in the organization and management of Health services, and carry out High specialty hospitalization and treatments and other activities having characteristics of excellence. The University of Pavia is a partner of these Hospitals in implementing clinical trials, medical assistance, teaching and research activities, for the benefit of both patients and study courses in the Medical-health field.

CNAO

Pavia's National Center for Oncological Hadrotherapy is an innovative and technologically advanced non-profit Foundation, established in 2001 by the Italian Ministry of Health for the treatment of radio-resistant and inoperable tumors through the use of carbon ions and protons. It is the only Hadrotherapy centre in Italy and one of the six in the world.

Besides healing its patients, CNAO is also a Research & Development centre whose activities range from radiobiological to translational clinical research, with the aim of proving a continual improvement in the capacity to cure. The University of Pavia is a scientific partner of CNAO in dealing with cancer therapy research works.

Innovation Ecosystem



EUCENTRE

Established in 2005 by the University of Pavia and other public institutions, **Pavia's European Centre for Training and Research in Earthquake Engineering** is a private non-profit Foundation that pursues the mission of research, training and provision of services in the field of Earthquake engineering and, more generally, of Risk engineering. EUCENTRE is a reference centre for international institutions - for which it operates in the definition of emergency plans, in the elaboration of risk scenarios, in the assessment of the vulnerability of buildings and infrastructures - and for companies, to which it offers support services for anti-seismic design in various sectors. Furthermore, along with the University of Pavia and the IUSS, the Center organizes training courses for students and professionals in the field of Seismic engineering and Risk management.

PARCO TECNICO SCIENTIFICO

Founded in 2007 by the University of Pavia and other public institutions, **Pavia's Technical-Scientific Park** is a company owned by the University of Pavia, whose purpose is to facilitate the interaction between the world of Research and the Market, supporting the scientific and cultural development of the territory. In PTS, companies with a scientific and technological vocation find a favourable environment for carrying out their activities and for exchanging skills and know-how.

Among the aims of PTS: sustaining the growth of new innovative Start Ups and Spin Offs, facilitating access to innovations and research for pioneering companies, increasing entrepreneurial culture and encouraging collaboration between University and Business.



POLO TECNOLOGICO

Pavia's Technological Hub is a private company whose purpose is to create business and work.

This innovative reality, founded in 2010, combines the supplying of spaces and technologies for firms with the chance to build up networks, partnerships and Start Ups to improve economic and entrepreneurial activity.

In this environment, where skills and knowledge are shared, the University of Pavia's research is considered as the ground to inspire innovative ideas and to foster the development of advanced projects and new businesses, through the engagement of students, entrepreneurs and investors.

PARCO CARDANO

Following an agreement between the University of Pavia and its public and private partners, and thanks to an initial funding of 12 million euros from the Lombardy Region, **Pavia's Sustainable Innovation Park** will be inaugurated by 2023.

The Park will consist of a Research and Training Centre and numerous infrastructures that will welcome companies that want to develop innovative projects, in collaboration with the University and other Research centres equipped with advanced scientific instrumentation. It will be an internationally competitive Technological Hub, capable of attracting brains from all over the world and companies with a high innovative content, also with a view to introducing students and graduates for internships and placement.

EMPLOYMENT RATE

The University of Pavia ranks **above the National average** in terms of the Employment Rate of its graduates.

AlmaLaurea is a National Interuniversity Consortium which represents 76 Italian Universities and about 90% of the overall graduates, and annually carries out surveys on the profile and employment status of graduates.

According to AlmaLaurea Report 2020, **85,1% of Unipv graduates find work within 1 year from graduation** (compared to a National average of 81,2%).

In general, Degrees in **Engineering, Medicine & Surgery and Pharmacy** show a higher post-graduation Employment Rate.

CAREER SERVICE

The Career Service of the University of Pavia carries out numerous services to facilitate the insertion of its students and graduates into the job market.

In addition to offering an updated **platform with the best Internship and Job offers**, both in Italy and abroad, and to organizing **events** with local enterprises and multinational companies during which students can conduct interviews, the Career Service provides **individual and personalized Job Advice**.

Furthermore, a section of the Service's website is dedicated to **information on initiatives related to job market**, calls for proposals, projects and challenges.

MASTER'S DEGREES PLUS - "LM +"

"LM +" are special Master's Degree programs, made up of **5 semesters** rather than 4. In the last 2 semesters students are offered a **training period in a company**, during which expenses are reimbursed (500-800 euros/month).

WORK EXPERIENCE AT THE UNIVERSITY PART-TIME COLLABORATIONS

The University of Pavia offers its students the opportunity to apply for a paid part-time collaboration **in one of the University's offices**, in order to help improve the University services. The required commitment varies from 50 to 150 hours per year. The selection is mainly based on the student's Academic merit and economic situation.

TUTORING

The University also offers its students the opportunity to carry out paid **tutoring activities for other students**, aimed at supporting the career path and well-being of students.

The activities are mainly divided into 3 types: informational tutoring, cognitive tutoring and psychological tutoring.

CULTURE OF INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The University of Pavia has undertaken various initiatives for the spread of the Culture of Innovation and Entrepreneurship within the University community.

UNIPV INNOVATION

UniPV Innovation is a project launched along with the association Pavia Activators, with the aim of promoting **networking between innovators and aspiring entrepreneurs**.

This community organizes competitions for the selection of business ideas, promotes youth entrepreneurial culture initiatives and presents successful business experiences.

UNIVENTURE

UniVenture is a **Business Plan Competition** organized in partnership with the Municipality of Pavia, aimed at stimulating innovation and entrepreneurship through the encounter between the **University environment and entrepreneurs** of the local economy.

The project is addressed to students with an entrepreneurial idea and to Start Ups and SMEs interested in collaborating with the University of Pavia, and involves the active participation of the Master's Degree course in "International business and entrepreneurship", which is in charge of the training of aspiring entrepreneurs.

For the development of the winning business idea, the University provides **funding and concrete support** in terms of skills, resources and visibility.



A Job-Oriented University

Services & Facilities

ONLINE SERVICES

Via the **Student portal** and the **App "MyUniPV"** students can check their account and access the various sections related to their University career, such as registration for exams, study plan, self-certifications, fees payment, average grade calculator, campus maps and so on.

Students are given an **Institutional email account** where all official communications from the University are conveyed, and inside the campuses they can access two **free WiFi networks**.

Kiro Blackboard is the **E-learning platform** of the University of Pavia, in which students can find teaching materials, in-depth exercises, exam tests, verification tests and many other activities in support of teaching.

UNIVERSITY CARDS

The **Ateneo card** is the identification card of Unipv students and is issued by Banca Popolare di Sondrio, the treasury bank of the University. The card can be activated -without any costs- as a prepaid rechargeable credit card and is used by the University to credit any refunds, scholarships and sums due for student collaborations. It can also be used in stores in contactless mode and for internet purchases.

The **Smart card** allows students to access controlled-entry libraries and to use free drinking water dispensers.

LIBRARIES AND STUDY ROOMS

The University offers **37 Academic libraries** run by different faculties and departments. All the owned material is listed in OPAC Electronic Catalogue (Online Public Access Catalogue).

There are also **6 Study rooms**, located both in the Humanities campus and in the Sciences campus, some of which are open also during evenings and weekends.

LANGUAGE CENTRE

The University of Pavia's Language Centre provides **language courses** -including Italian- throughout the whole Academic year, according to different options: semester course or one-month intensive course.

MUSEUMS

The University's Museum System offers a **variety of museums and collections** of interest to both students and the general public. The museums are free for Unipv students.

CANTEENS

The Canteen Service runs **5 canteens** close to both the Humanities campus and the Sciences campus, some of which are open also during evenings and weekends.

Students can access the canteens at a special price: a complete meal from 4 to 6,50 euros, according to the student's economic situation.

FACILITIES FOR SPECIAL NEED STUDENTS

The University's **Centre for Special Need Students** (S.A.I.S.D.) takes care of the facilities for students with special needs, coordinating and monitoring all the initiatives related to the integration of these students in all aspects of University life.

PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELLING

The service is free of charge and is offered both in Italian and English. The interviews with psychologists have a maximum duration of 50 minutes and take place via Zoom video-call platform.

TRANSPORT DISCOUNT

The University of Pavia, in partnership with the local bus company, offers all students "Uni-Pass", an **Urban bus pass** at the special price of 20 euros per year. Moreover it offers a 10% discount on National and International **FlixBus rides**, which is valid once a month.

Our University Residence System, unique in Italy

COLLEGI

Just like Oxford and Cambridge in the UK, Pavia has a Collegiate Residence System, unique in Italy, dating back to the 16th century.

Each of **Pavia's 21 Residences ("Collegio")**, that in total host approximately 2.000 students, has its own particular history and opportunities to offer, including the chance to build close relationships and helpful professional networks. In fact, Residence life is not only accommodation and study, but also an opportunity to acquire a sense of belonging to a community where academic achievements, traditional events, parties and sporting rivalries play a key role.

Pavia provides **11 Public Residences managed by EDiSU** (Agency for the Right to Study), with acceptance based on merit and income requirements;

5 Merit-based Residences, with acceptance based on a competition; **5 Private Residences**.

The accommodation costs range from 0 to 350 euros, according to the student's economic situation, the accommodation type (single or double room) and the Residence itself.

The calls for application are generally published around July.

EDiSU also manages **1 Residence located in Cremona** (Collegio Quartier Novo), aimed at students of Musicology and Cultural Heritage.

PRIVATE ACCOMMODATION

If you are unable to find a place in a Residence or you prefer another solution, you can look for a room privately. From abroad you can search for rental announcements on specific websites or Facebook groups, while when you are in Italy you can rely on Notice boards located inside the University's buildings or on Real estate agencies. The costs of a room in a flat can range from 150 to 350 euros per month, according to the accommodation type (single or double room) and the City's area.

C.U.S.

The **University of Pavia's Sports Center** ("Centro Universitario Sportivo - C.U.S.") was founded in 1946, and currently has over 2.800 members.

It carries out sports activities on non-competitive and competitive levels, both in the University circuit (for instance, participation in the University National Championships and in the World University Games) and in the circuit of the National Sports Federations.

Courses available include: climbing, athletics, canoeing, rowing, volleyball, rugby, fencing, archery, fitness and sports activities specifically designed for students with disabilities.

In particular the University of Pavia is famous for its participation in the "**Pavia-Oxford-Cambridge-Pisa rowing race**" and, in general, for this discipline at Olympic and World Championship-level.

Facilities consist of three multi-purpose gyms, a weight room, a fitness area, an exercise trail with gymnastic equipment, outside and inside swimming pools, a spa, a fencing room, a rugby field, a football/archery field, a field for 5-man football, two beach volley courts and canoeing-rowing facilities on the left bank of the Ticino river.

PAVIA

Pavia has a lot to offer in terms of sports activities and facilities, and in 2014 it was internationally recognized as "**European City of Sport**" thanks to its enduring excellence in this field.

For walkers and runners there are beautiful trails in Ticino Park and Vernavola Park, for cyclists safe paths throughout the whole City, whilst our Sports Center offers courses and organizes University championships and Intercollegiate tournaments in numerous disciplines.

How can you reconcile professional sports activity with studying?

It is not easy, but I am driven by the passion for both. Sport is my life, even though I also want to specialize in Genetics. Therefore it does not matter how hard it is, but how much you strive to do it.

How did your passion for swimming originate?

Actually, I was forced to undertake this sport! I started swimming when I was a two-year-old child as a form of therapy, since I suffer from spastic diplegia affecting my legs. Afterwards it turned into a passion. Then in 2013 Davide Bellingeri launched the project "Nuota con noi" (Swim with us) whose aim was to create a Para swimming professional team in Pavia.

Apart from athletics, what do you expect in your future life?

I want to carry out research in Biotechnology in order to find treatments for undiagnosed diseases.

GRADUATION DAY

The Graduation Day is the largest event, taking up the tradition of English and American colleges, in which **the University of Pavia celebrates its graduates**. The ceremony, launched in 1991, is traditionally held on the first Saturday of July and opens with the entrance of the **Academic parade** in the Theresian Courtyard, followed by the welcome address of the Rector.

The main speech is given by **successful Unipv Alumni** who have reached high professional achievements during their career.

First-class honors graduates then receive the parchment directly from Faculty Presidents and Department Directors, and **Degree Prizes** are awarded. At the end of the Ceremony, refreshments are held in the historic courtyards of the University.

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The Alumni Association of the University of Pavia was established in 2004, with the latin motto **"Meminisse iuvabit"** (meaning "One day it will be pleasant to remember the current events"). NON-EU APPLICANTS HOLDING A VISA/RESIDENCE PERMIT FOR STUDY

Applicants can choose to pay the tuition fee according to one of the following options.

OPTION 1

The tuition fee is **adjusted to the student's economic situation** and is composed of two parts (per year):

1. **Fixed Fee:** 156 euros (Regional Tax);

2. **Variable Fee:** calculated on the basis of the student's Area of Study and I.S.E.E. (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator). It ranges from 0 to 4.463 euros. For students whose I.S.E.E. is ≤ 23.000 euros the variable fee is 0.

The submission of financial documents (translated into Italian and legalized/apostilled) is mandatory.

OPTION 2

The tuition fee consists in a **Flat Rate** set on the basis of the student's Area of Study and Citizenship, according to three brackets. It ranges from 400 to 4.500 euros per year. No financial documents are required.

Funding

FEE WAIVER

The University of Pavia every year awards International students **100 Tuition Fee Waivers** providing exemption from the payment of the University tuition fee (only the payment of the Regional Tax is required). Applicants must enroll in **one of the eligible courses** and fulfill another minimum requirement from 3 options.

EDISU PAVIA SCHOLARSHIP

EDISU (Ente per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario) is the Agency for the Right to Study established by the University of Pavia. Edisu scholarship benefits for **all level applicants** include:

Accommodation in a Residence;

One meal per day at the canteens;

A sum of money, according to the student's economic situation.

The assignment of the scholarship is subject to the fulfillment of merit and income requirements.

SUBJECT-SPECIFIC SCHOLARSHIP

Two Master's Degree programs (**Civil engineering for mitigation of risk from natural hazards** and **Molecular biology and genetics**) award scholarships to the most deserving International applicants, according to a merit-based evaluation. The scholarship provides a monthly grant.

"INVEST YOUR TALENT IN ITALY"

The Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs offers scholarships to applicants from specific countries, fulfilling some merit requirements and enrolling in 3 Master's Degree courses (**Electronic engineering; International business and entrepreneurship; Economics, finance and international integration**) and 1 Vocational program (**Cooperation and development**).

The scholarship provides a Tuition Fee exemption (Regional Tax excluded) and a monthly grant, and also includes an internship in an Italian company.

"STUDY IN ITALY"

The Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs also assigns scholarships to applicants from specific countries, fulfilling some merit requirements and enrolling in **Master's Degree and PhD programs**.

The scholarship provides a Tuition Fee exemption (Regional Tax excluded) and a monthly grant.

"STUDY A MASTER'S IN EUROPE"

Educatons.com offers funds to help cover the whole Tuition Fee to applicants from any countries who want to study a **Master's Degree** within Europe. The selection process is based on merit requirements.

Preparatory programs



MARCO POLO - TURANDOT

Marco Polo-Turandot is a **Preparatory program of Italian language and culture, addressed to Chinese applicants.**

The program was launched in Italy in 2006, in order to increase the number of Chinese students enrolled in Italian Universities, Academies and Conservatories.

The University of Pavia started its own Program in 2007, the very first year of the project, offering a top-level, **10-months full immersion** teaching program with classes taught entirely in Italian by highly qualified personnel. The program, which has been tested through the years, includes **Italian language classes**, a **course on Italian culture**, as well as specific **curricular contents** and a **test-training course** designed to help students prepare for the final exams. At the end of the program the students are expected to take at least **one of two final exams**:

Marco Polo official exam, level B1, which is mandatory for those students who wish to enroll in a Bachelor/Master at the University of Pavia, and exempt from the Italian proficiency University admission test;

CILS Certificate, level B1 (issued by the Foreigners University of Siena), which is mandatory for those students who wish to leave Pavia to get their Bachelor/Master.

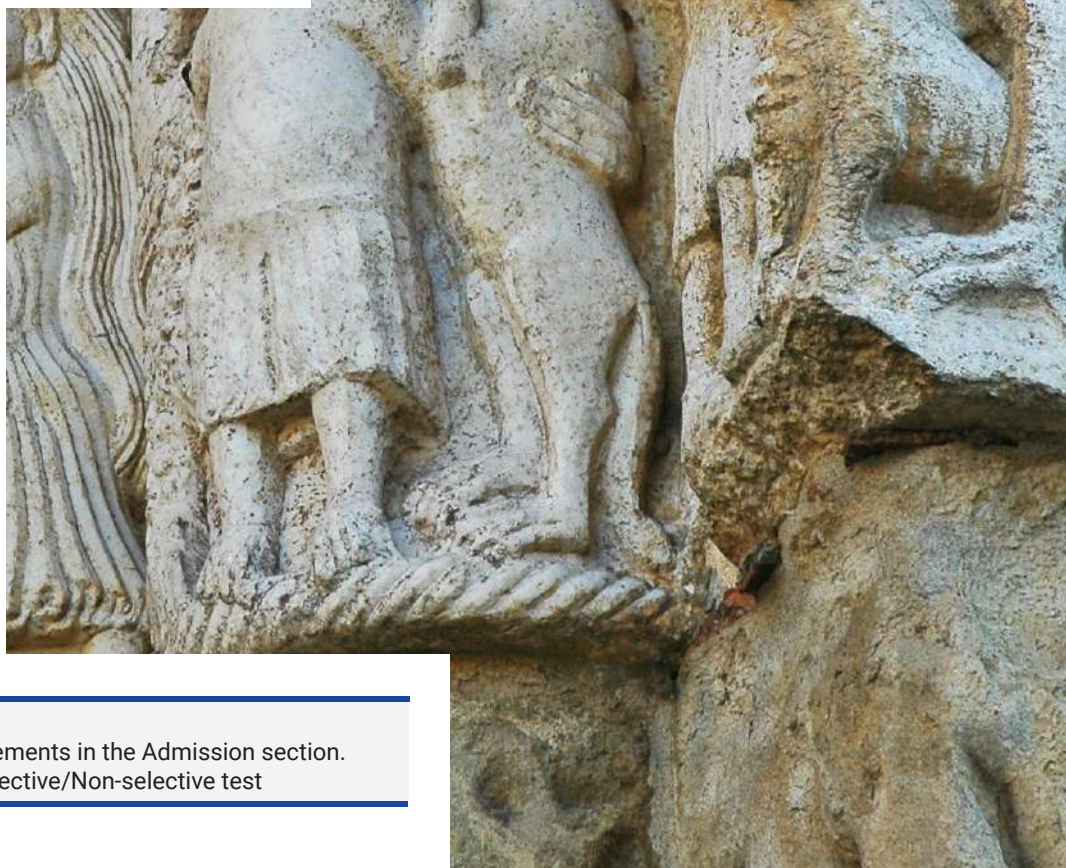

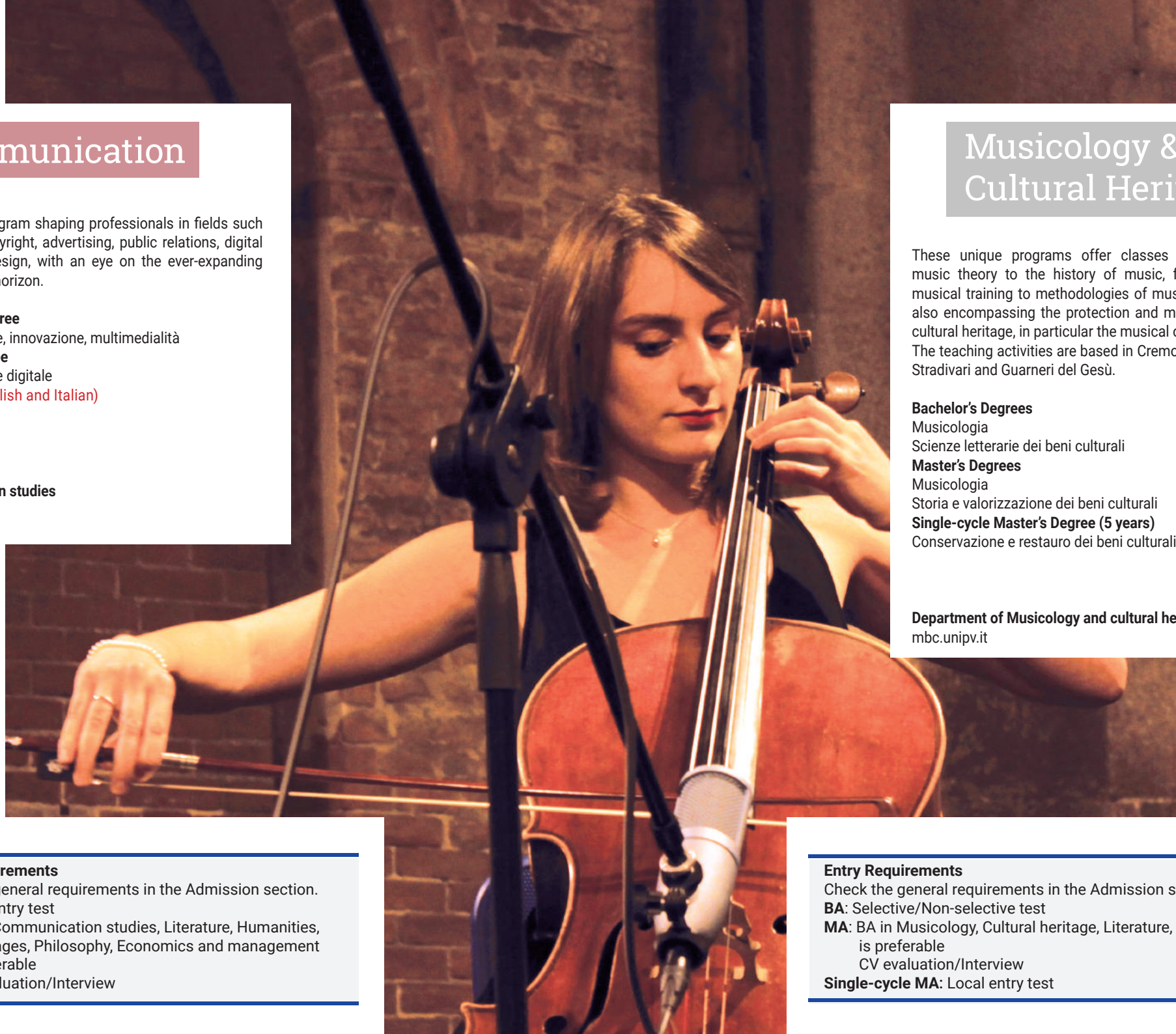

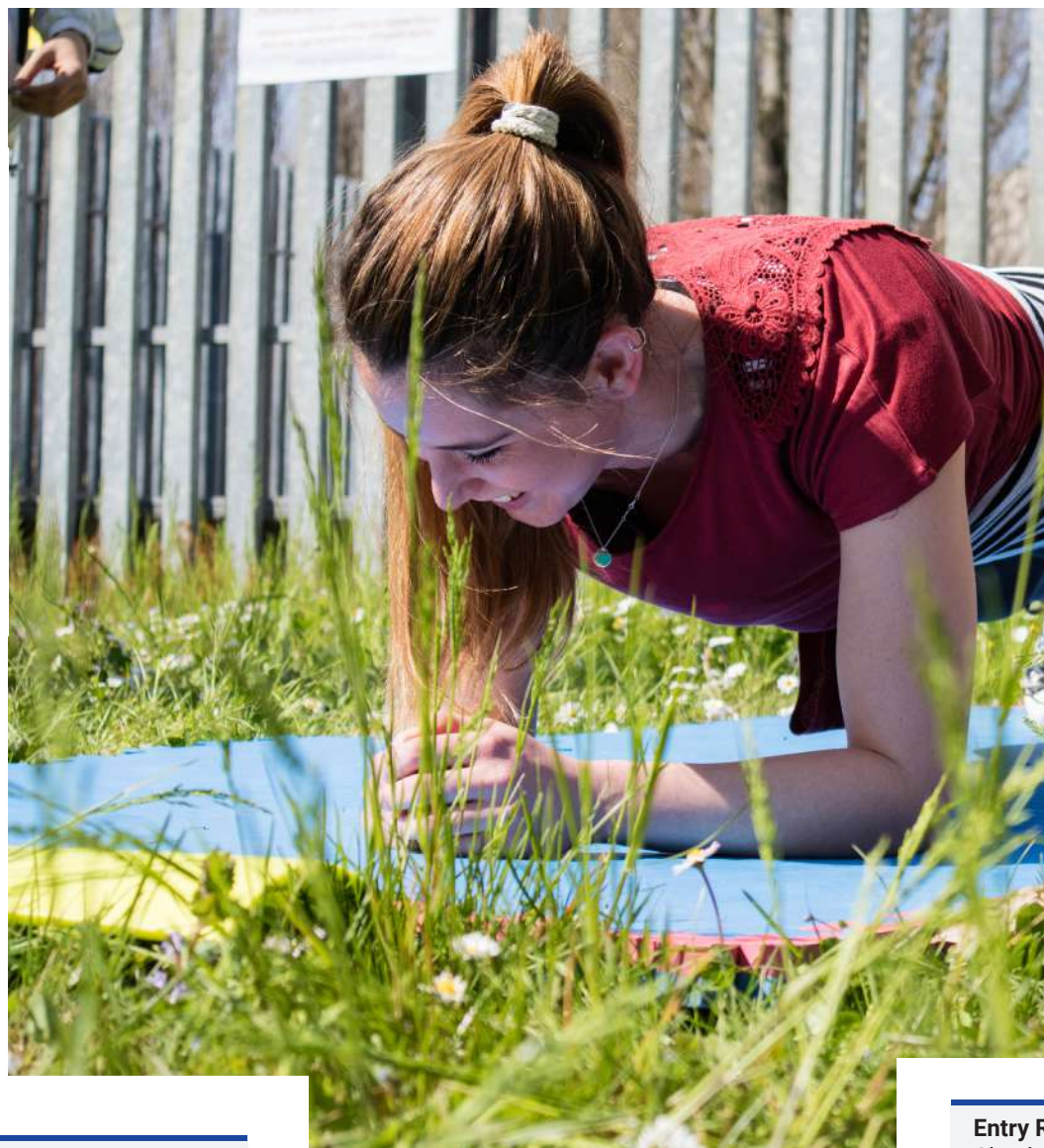

The program includes an intensive Italian language course, addressed to Non-Italian students, during the summer before its beginning. ENI offers a number of **full scholarships** that cover the tuition fee and include a monthly cash allowance.

Students are prepared to work in institutions like NGOs, International organizations, Governmental bureaus, Research centres and other public or private Institutions. The program offers both a theoretical part, made of classes and seminars, and an internship from 3 up to 6 months, which can be either an on-the-field experience with one of the partner organizations or a research period in an International institution.

The program offers **full or partial scholarships** to meritorious students coming from developing countries. Other public or private sources of funding are compatible with the course.

Excellence starts here

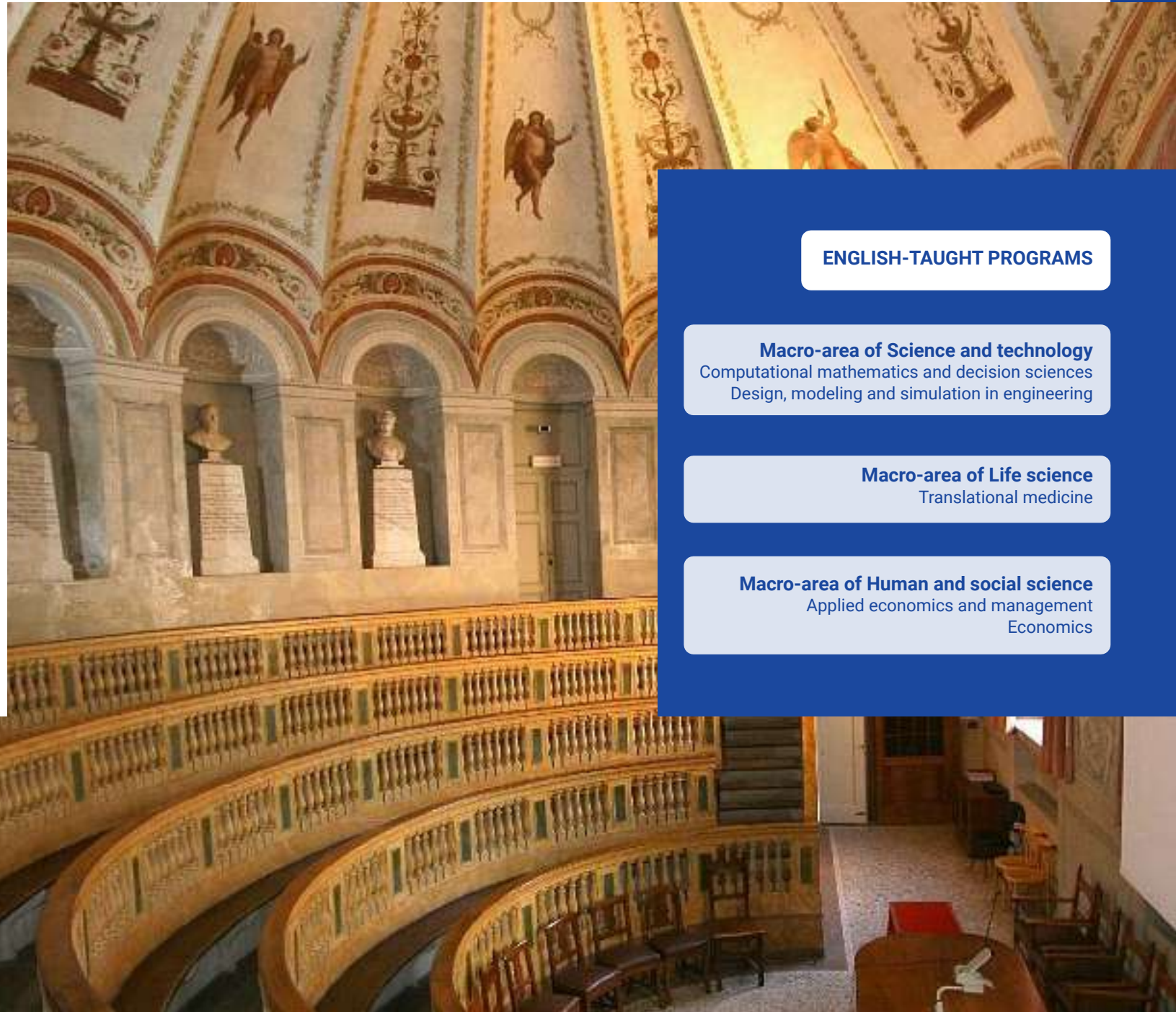
The University of Pavia offers **24 PhD programs** which allow students to develop not only their skills in view of future careers in Academia, but also abilities that can be exploited outside the University. These **3-years programs** cover a wide range of topics and are organized into three macro-areas: Science and technology, Life science, Human and social science.

The PhD Higher Education School (SAFD), which supervises the programs, actively promotes interactions with industry and International programs, including Joint Degrees with other European institutions.

Candidates holding a Master's Degree (in subjects related to the PhD of interest) are selected in a public competition involving the evaluation of the qualifications, a written exam and an interview.

The programs offer a number of **scholarships**, assigned according to the ranking of the public competition. The amount of the scholarship is increased in case of research periods carried out at foreign institutions. Self-funded students pay a tuition fee of 156 euros per year.

The Schools pertain to three areas: Medical area, Surgical area and Clinical services area. The admission involves specific requirements for each School, as well as passing a National competition.

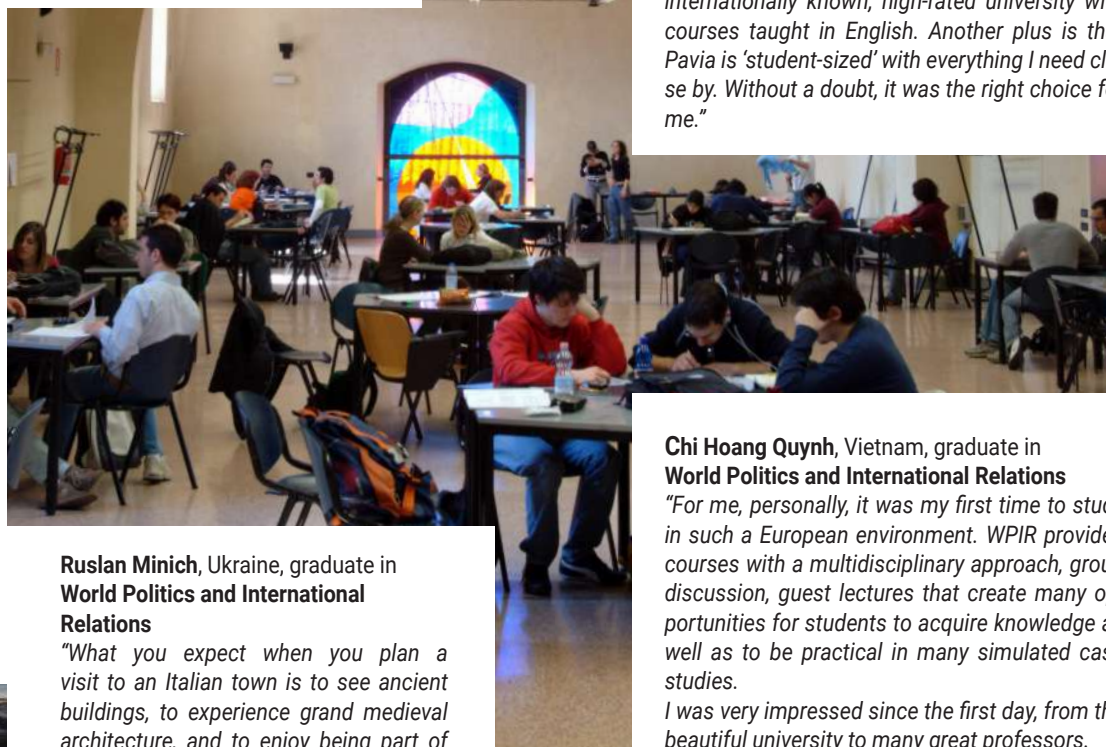
